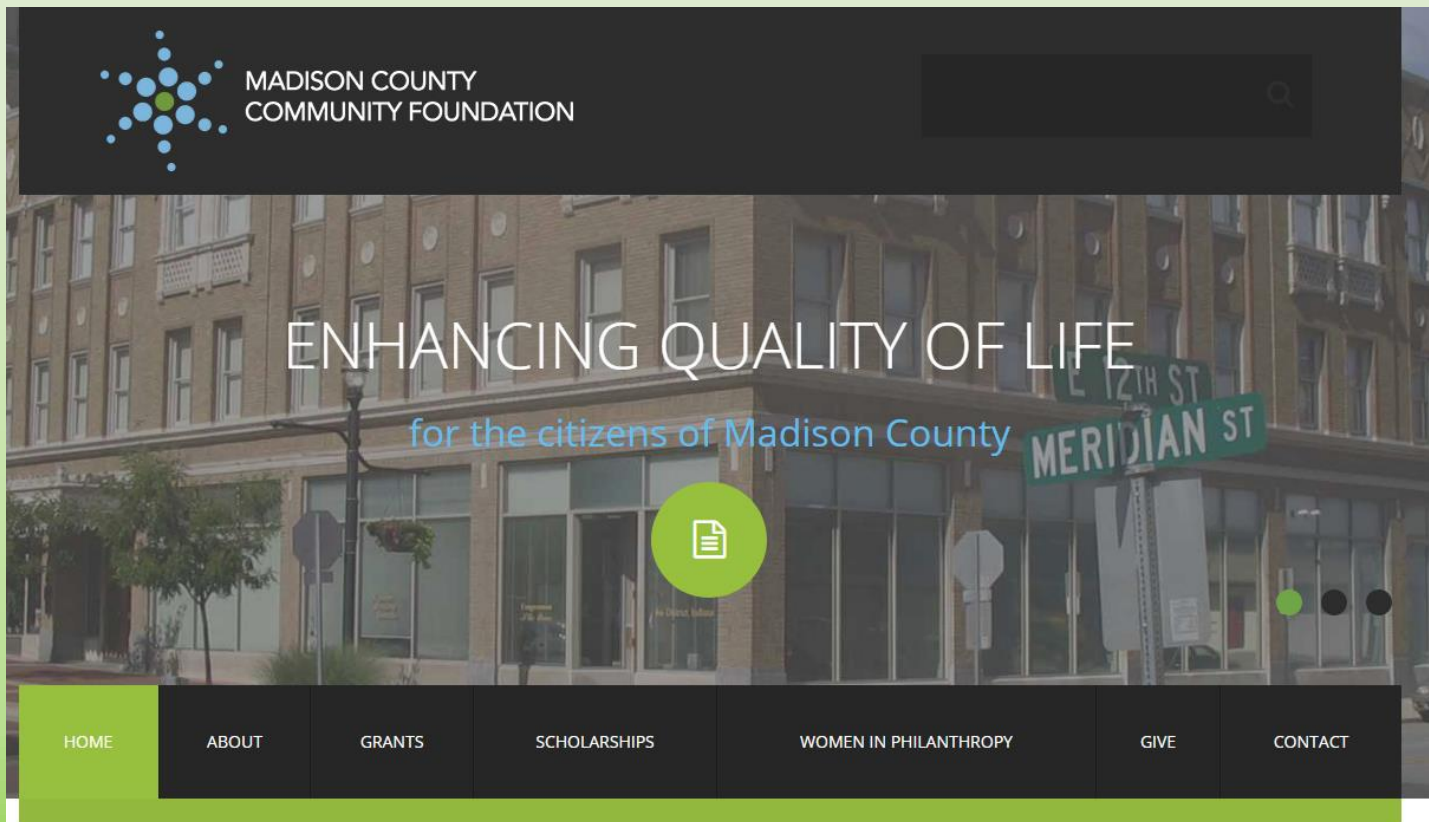

Community Impact Grants

Community Impact Grants: Beginning in 2022, grant applications are accepted quarterly, each year the grant cycle dates will be posted. Grants are made to support projects and programs of non-profit agencies located in or serving residents of Madison County. Grants are typically made for one year, at a maximum of \$10,000. Proposals are reviewed by a diverse committee made up of community volunteers and Board Members, which makes funding recommendations to the Foundation Board of Directors. Upon approval by the Board of Directors, funds are awarded.

The Madison County Community Foundation is generally interested in funding the following:

- Efforts that address the root causes of clearly defined needs within Madison County such as eliminating the cycle of poverty.
- Efforts with specific goals, objectives and indicators with which to measure effectiveness.
- Efforts that foster a collaborative spirit, partnerships and innovation among various organizations, agencies and individuals serving Madison County.
- Efforts that benefit or serve a large number or percentage of Madison County residents.



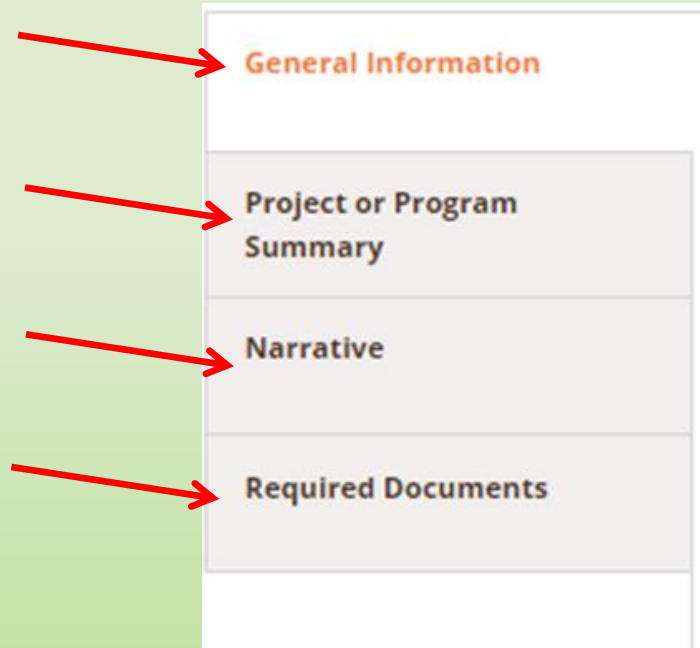
