2024 Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship Details

The primary purposes of the Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship Program are 1) to help raise the level of educational attainment in Indiana; 2) to increase awareness of the beneficial roles Indiana community foundations can play in their communities; and 3) to encourage and support the efforts of current and past Lilly Endowment Community Scholars to engage with each other and with Indiana business, governmental, educational, nonprofit and civic leaders to improve the quality of life in Indiana generally and in local communities throughout the state.

Madison County's 2024 Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship shall be awarded to two students, who will be provided full tuition, required fees, and a special allocation of up to \$900 per year for required books and required equipment for four years of undergraduate study on a full-time basis, leading to a baccalaureate degree at any Indiana public or private college or university accredited by the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools. The Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship for Madison County is administered by the Madison County Community Foundation. In our selection process, applications will be reviewed by a committee of community members. Evaluations are completed anonymously without disclosure of applicant contact information.

Applicants will be evaluated on the following: • Academic performance: 20% • Community leadership: 30 % • Extra-Curricular Activities: 30 % • Application and Essay: 20 % Finalist interviews will be held on Wednesday, October 4, 2023. You must be available on this date if selected as a finalist.
